<u>Class Schedules</u>: Students may view their schedules in PowerSchool. However, times are incorrect for all courses. Please ignore the blocks and teachers assigned for CPCC classes in PowerSchool and follow the steps below to view your <u>CPCC courses</u>:

- Log in to your MyCollege account (<a href="https://mycollege.cpcc.edu/">https://mycollege.cpcc.edu/</a>). If your CPCC log-in information is not working, please contact CPCC's IT helpdesk at 704-330-5000.
- Click on Student Planning
- On the right, near the calendar icon, click on "Go to Plan and Schedule"
- Use the arrows on the left to click to Fall 2021 semester
- The easiest way to view your schedule is to click on the Print button.

If a time shows "TBD Online Course," the class has an online component that does not have a meeting time. The online component of CPCC classes will take place on Brightspace. Resources for using this platform can be found here: https://researchguides.cpcc.edu/brightspace

<u>Schedule Changes</u>: Middle College High School students must be enrolled in a total of four or more classes for the fall semester, with at least one college course. Spring CPCC classes will be scheduled in November. <u>Students must get approval from Ms. Van Lauwe for all schedule changes.</u> The last day to change a fall high school class is August 13, 2021. Changes to the college schedule must be completed by August 17, 2021. Students who drop CPCC courses after the 10% date will receive a W, which converts to a WF on the CMS transcript. The 35% date that you will see on the CPCC course syllabus applies to "paying students" only.

Students wishing to make changes to their schedules before school starts need to meet with Ms. Van Lauwe during her scheduled Zoom drop-in hours listed below. Only one student will be admitted into the Zoom room at a time, so please be patient if you are in the waiting room.

<u>Textbooks</u>: CMS textbooks will be issued by each CMS teacher. CPCC textbooks are available from the oncampus bookstore (Mon-Fri 8:00-5:00) or online at cpcc.bncollege.com. Your CPCC student ID number is required for online purchases and your actual CPCC student ID is required for in-store purchases. CPCC textbooks for first semester may be purchased between August 9th and August 31st. Additional information regarding purchasing CPCC textbooks online can be found at <a href="https://bit.ly/CPCCTextbookOrder">https://bit.ly/CPCCTextbookOrder</a>. Students and parents will not need to pay any money out of pocket for textbooks.

<u>Transportation:</u> Middle college students have three transportation options: 1) Drive to school (no parking pass needed for Levine campus), 2) Parents drop off at school, and 3) CATS transportation. Bus Passes will be distributed to students at the beginning of each month. Students are responsible for keeping track of their monthly CATS pass. CMS will not replace lost or stolen passes.
