All Classes meet with ALL students using the same schedule each day on Monday-Friday with ½ of the students in classes on-site and ½ of the students in the same classes online.

On any day that the school building should be 'closed' for Health reasons, all classes will still meet online using the same schedule.

Further Information:

***** *Building Opens for Students at 8:25 a.m.* – Doors #3 and #13 will open at 8:25 a.m. Students will not be allowed to enter the building prior to 8:25 a.m. unless in Zero Period Marching Band, verified for an organizational or other meeting, practice, workout, or study session with a teacher. Face masks must be worn upon entry and during time within the building.

****** *Lunches and Study Table* – A one-hour lunch and study table will be held. Students with signed parent permission forms in respective grade level offices will be allowed to leave campus during lunch. Lunch I and II will be determined by a student's 6th period/3rd block class. Students will remain in 6th period or 3rd block classes for a learning center opposite of their lunch session.

******* *RTI/Review/Homework/Enrichment/Extension Sessions* – These scheduled times will be designated as either required or requested assistance/work study in each class. Students will be required to attend the session for any class if receiving a 'D' level, 'not passing', or incomplete grade, or any priority standard score of '2' or below in a class. Students wanting extra review/support/enrichment may request and attend the RTI Sessions. Teachers may also choose to use this time for assessment/lab extension/lesson extension or other reasons as needed for the class.
