Anderson Perry (City of Reedsport): \$750.00 Open to a graduating RCCS senior who is planning to attend a two year or four-year college. GPA 3.0+ Preference to students majoring in science (preferably engineering).

Anandapure Aspiring Scientist or Engineer: \$1000, Open to students with a minimum GPA of 3.25 (SAT of 1100, ACT of 22) pursuing a science or engineering degree at a 4-year college. 250-word essay of why the student chose his/her major. Final selection based on a personal interview.

Anandapure Aspiring Tradesperson: \$1000, Open to students attending a vocational or trade school. Requires submission of a photo of something that the student has made along with a paragraph about why this project was important to the student. Final selection based on a personal interview.

Aurora Masonic Lodge #59 & Rebecca's Scholarship: \$500: Open to a graduating RCCS senior who is planning to attend a two year or four-year college.

Butch Thompson Memorial Scholarship: \$500: Open to seniors admitted to and planning to attend the University of Oregon in Eugene. Please include a copy of your U of O admission letter with this application.

Dunes Art Club \$1,000.00: Open to a graduating RCCS senior who is planning to attend a two-year or four-year college. Three Samples of art work must be submitted. Can be photos of art, interview required.

Dunes Community Health Services Scholarship: Multiple awards ranging from \$500 to \$1,750: Open to seniors planning to pursue a degree in nursing, medicine, physical therapy, medical technology, or other health career.

Eagles Scholarship: 2 scholarships of \$250. GPA 2.5 going into college or trade school.

Friends of Reedsport OLCC Scholarship: Multiple awards of various amounts. Open to RCCS seniors with a GPA of 2.5 or higher, who are planning to attend a vocational or trade school.

Gardiner Odd Fellows \$750.00: Open to a graduating RCCS senior who is planning to attend a two or four-year college. **Hair 101 Beauty and Barber Scholarship: \$250**: Open to seniors who will be attending a beauty or barber school upon high school graduation.

Lakeside Community Women's Club Scholarship: \$500: Open to a graduating senior who resides in Lakeside or Hauser. A minimum 3.0 GPA and demonstration of financial need are required (See Mrs. Donnelly for financial need requirement). Applicant must be enrolled in a two-year or four-year college.

Leslie B Freeman Engineering Scholarship \$1,000.00: One to two-page letter specific to an interest in the field of engineering.

Marlene Tymchuk Memorial Scholarship \$1,000.00: Students must have a 3.0+ GPA or higher and need to submit a 300-word essay About your favorite teacher and how they positively influenced your life.

Marne Humphreys Memorial Scholarship \$1,000.00: Students must have a 3.0+ GPA or higher and need to submit a 250-word essay About your favorite book and why it is your favorite. (Cannot be to Kill a Mocking Bird).

Moose 2442 Marjorie Falk Scholarship four, \$500.00: Open to RCCS seniors.

Oregon Coast Anglers Scholarship \$500: No scholastic requirement, 200-word essay on conservation interest.

Partners in Education \$250.00 – 500.00: Open to RCCS seniors attending a community college or university.

Reedsport A.R.E.-Two \$500 scholarships preference for education

Reedsport School Board-several scholarships varying amounts requirements TBA.

Reedsport Education Enrichment Foundation (REEF) Marjean Lewis Memorial Scholarships: Multiple awards ranging from \$500 to \$1,000: Students must have a minimum 2.50 GPA.

Reedsport Education Enrichment Foundation (REEF) Zack Turner Scholarship: \$500: Open to seniors with a minimum 3.50 GPA.

Ryan Clardy Scholarship: \$500: Open to RCCS seniors with a GPA of 2.5 or higher who are planning to attend a vocational or trade school.

Steve & Jerome Kenagy/Wes Lockard Scholarship Foundation Scholarship: \$3,000: Open to students pursuing a four-year college education with an emphasis on electronic media.

Ten Mile Bass Club Scholarship: \$500: Open to RCCS seniors who are majoring in fish & wildlife, natural resources, biology, or forestry. Students must have a 2.5 GPA or higher and need to submit an essay describing their involvement with a fish & wildlife project.
