
Camera Settings

high f-stop (small aperture), light meter for correct shutter speed. ISO 100. automatic focus

Setting up your camera:

- 1. Find a nice landscape where there is a large amount of interest. Remember the compositional rules we've been through (rule of thirds and perspective are ideal for landscapes). Use a tripod. When you use high f-stop you need a slower shutter. This will require a very still camera.
- 2. If you have running water in your landscape scenery, a longer shutter speed will make water appear milky.
- 3. Select your f-stop and use the light meter to select the ideal shutter speed.
