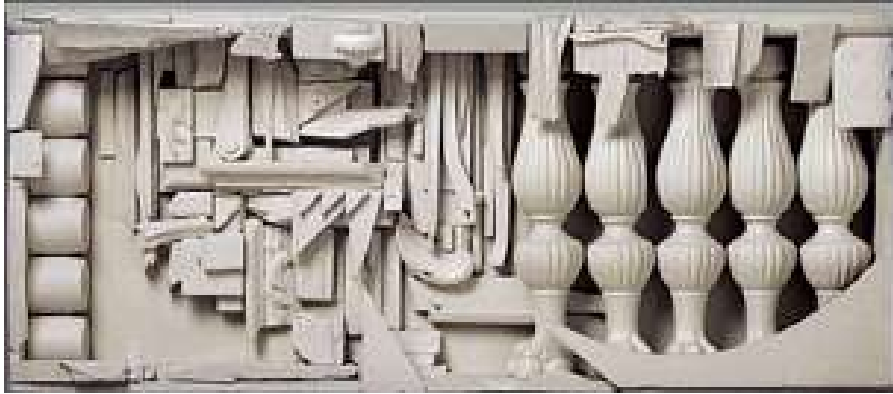


Name:

Who is Louise Nevelson? Louise Nevelson is an American artist (born in 1899 in Russia) who lived and worked in New York City. She liked to experiment with different materials and she especially loved to use junk she found on the streets of New York. She became famous for her monochromatically (one color) painted assemblage sculptures. She even referred to herself as “the original recycler”.



Terms to know:

Found Object Art- Using objects to make art that are not usually used to make art, stuff that is laying around or that has been thrown away.

Assemblage- Grouping of objects

Monochromatic- using only one color
