1. Opening of meeting

4. Attendance

Last year attendance we had a lot of students missing 30 or more days. As a way to encourage students to come to school we have come up with 3 incentives for good attendance.

1. Classrooms- Classes will spell the word attendance; once they do the teacher will let Mrs. Messinger know and she will reward the whole class. In order to get a letter ALL students must be in the classroom by 8:00.
2. Monthly prize- students who have perfect attendance for the month will get a prize
3. 5 days- On Mondays, any student who has been to school all 5 days of school during the previous week will be called into the hallway and dance a song that is being played over the intercom.

LSIC discussed getting prizes for students to be given away for either a monthly or end of year reward for perfect attendance.

After 5 days of excused/unexcused absences Mrs. Messenger is calling home to check on students. A letter is sent home after 10 absences.

5. October Field Trips

October 3rd, grades K-1 will go to Capital High School to see the play Winnie the Pooh and then go to the Cultural Center.

October 31st, grades 2nd-5th will go to the Clay Center.

This year's Halloween Party will be on Wednesday, October 30th.
