
### Mrs. Carleigh Dunbar






## Syllabus/Curriculum

Your program/subject curriculum is an important information that parents look out for when they visit your site. You can post your syllabus/curriculum using two methods:

#### 1. Using the content app:

- Use the Content app for adding text to your page.
  You can also add images and links to your page. This app is adaptive which means the content you create looks great when viewed on any device.
  Adding your content within the content app makes moving and arranging content easier.
- Drag the Content app onto your page if you do not already have one.
- Type or copy and paste your syllabus information in content app




## Syllabus/Curriculum

#### 2. Using the Document viewer app:

The Document Viewer app, powered by Google Docs™ Viewer, allows you to display a document on a page on your end-user website. Use the app to provide documents that you want your users to have access to at any time while providing them the option to download and print it. Class schedules, course syllabi, or terms and conditions documents can be easily displayed using this app. Visitors can move through the pages, zoom in and out, open the document in a new window, and download the file.








## Learning Links







### Contact Teacher

#### 2. Using the "Map Page to Web Address"
