Focusing

90% of the time, use autofocus. Sometimes you have to switch to Manual Focus



Examples of times to switch


- Doing light painting in darkened room or very low light
- When trying to shoot through glass or a fence


Figuring what aperture & shutter speed to use





If you take your picture with these settings, will the picture be too bright or too dark?


### Over-exposed or too bright

#### Under exposed or too dark






What about with these settings?

If you're using a tripod, then you will probably get a good picture. But if you get a blurry picture, it's probably due to camera shake. The shutter speed 1/20 is too slow to hand hold.
