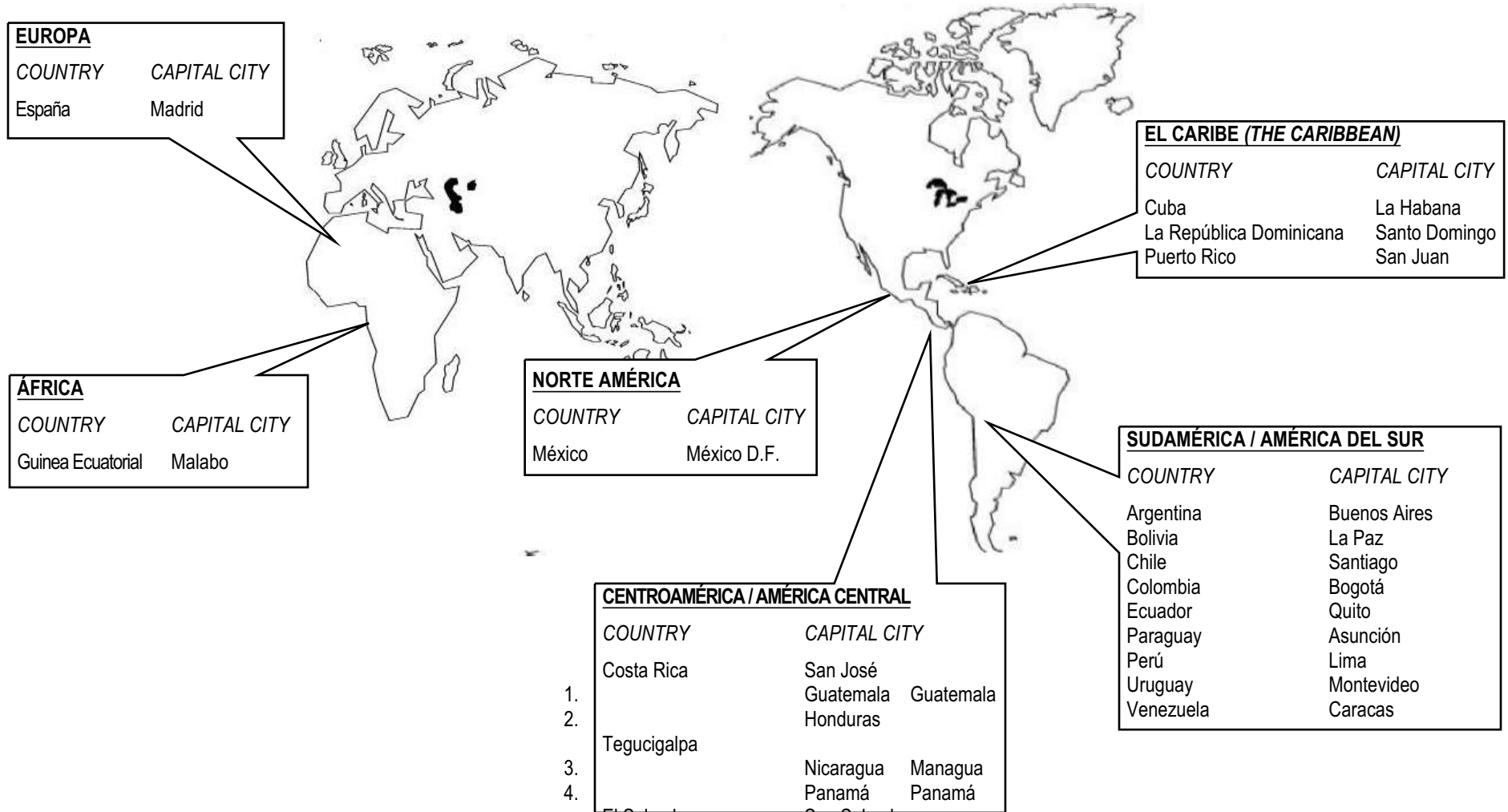


SPANISH SPEAKING COUNTRIES OF THE WORLD

The 21 countries that have Spanish as the Official Language



EXTRA CREDIT – (COUNTRIES ONLY):

Belice: Below Mexico and next to Guatemala in Central America. English is the official language.

Jamaica: The island below Cuba in the Caribbean. English is the official language.

Haiti: Island to the right of Cuba - the left half of the island only. French is the official language.

Portugal: Next to Spain (España) on the left side, in Europe. Portuguese is the official language.

Instructions - On the map: Correctly label the 9 Spanish-speaking countries of South America, and each capital city. Mark the capital city with a dot or star where each city is located.



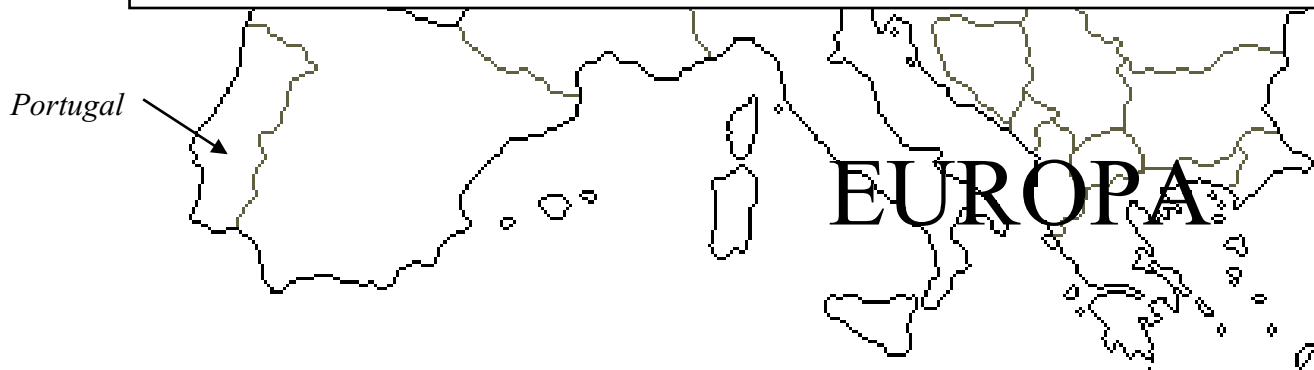

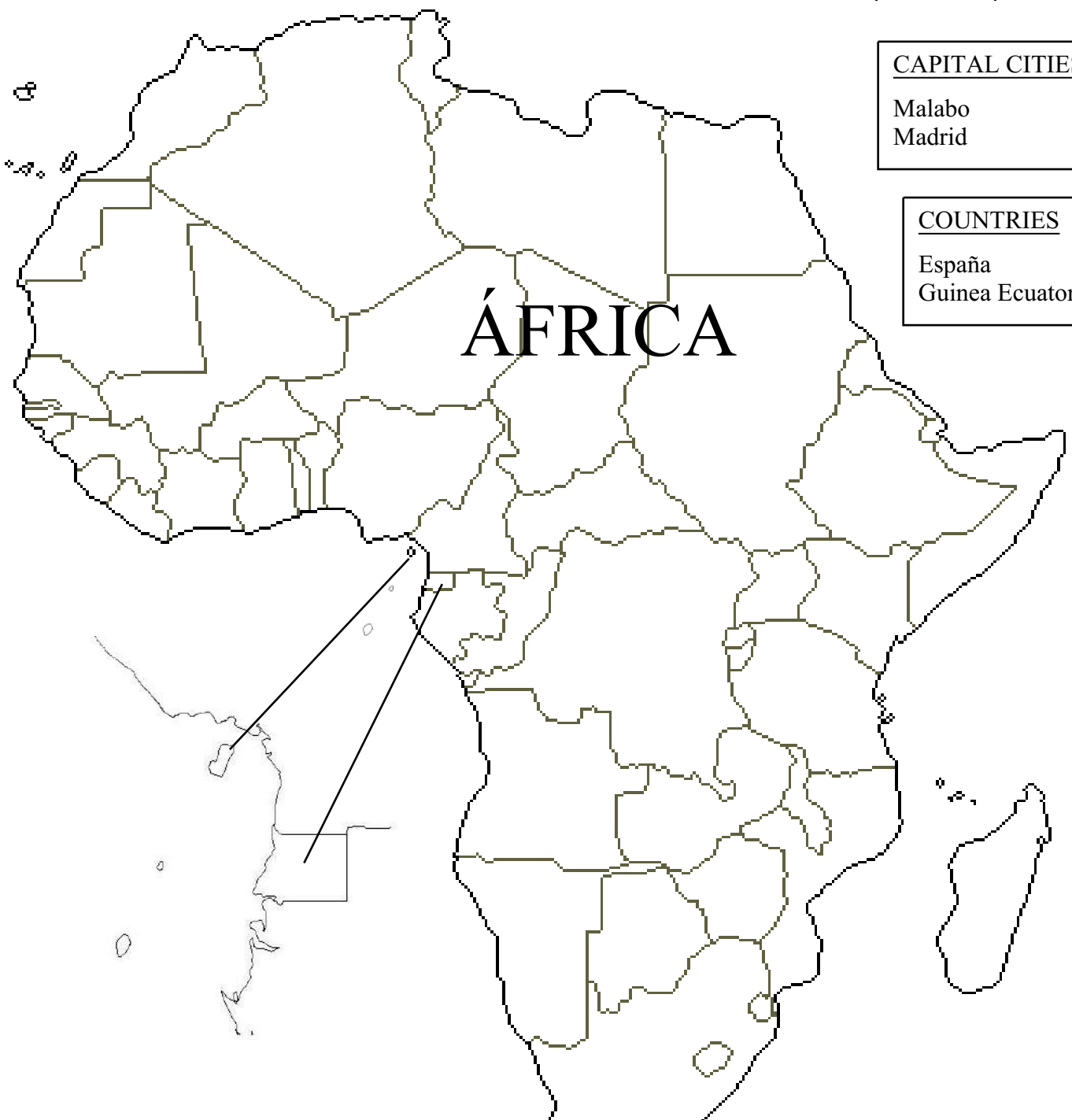
