This is Jerry McLaughlin, Superintendent of Schools with a brief update.

As you may be aware, the Pennsylvania Department of Education has cancelled all PSSA and Keystone Testing for the remainder of the 2019-2020 School Year. At this time, the Advanced Placement (AP) Exams are still scheduled and more guidance will be released at a later date.

The Loyalsock Township School District is preparing a plan to educate our students in the event that the Governor extends the statewide school closing beyond March 29, 2020.

This will take a great deal of effort, but I am confident that we can deliver sound educational programming for our students to your homes starting on March 30, 2020. Our teachers and administrators are working together and we will release more information next week.

In order to better serve our families, we have set up a survey that you can access on the main page of our website at www.loyalsocklancers.org. This survey will allow us to determine the percentage of families that have internet access and if they have devices in which they can connect.

In the meantime, we have set up enrichment resources for our students to access at all levels. These resources are opportunities for our students to stay active in the learning process.
