Important Message: Car Rider Line Safety

Parents: In the morning as you approach the car rider line, it is very important that you pull your vehicle all the way forward to the front of the line (end of sidewalk near the bus lot) before stopping to let your child/ children out. Some students prefer to enter at the front of the building, while others prefer the side entrance. However, for safety reasons, everyone must pull up all the way forward and once the line stops moving, then your child needs to exit your vehicle.

Also, all visitors must be buzzed into the front door and then sign in at the front office to get a visitor badge before proceeding down either hallway.

Favorite thing to do when not at school: Work at the house on projects with my husband, John. Travel with family and friends

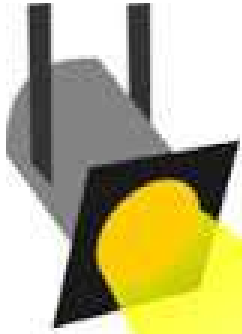
