

Tis the Season.... Time for Testing!

After we return from Spring Break 3-5 graders will be taking the Smarter Balanced English Language Arts and Math state assessments. These are important tests but just two indicators of many we use to assess student progress. Here are some things you can do to help your child prepare.

Remind them to work harder and get smarter!

Make sure they are getting to bed early and sleeping well.

Have them eat a healthy breakfast.

Tell them to relax and do their best.



This Spring, all elementary schools in Bend-La Pine will be using the Naglieri Non-Verbal Ability Test (NNAT) to screen students for possible identification for intellectual giftedness. The NNAT is a measure of nonverbal reasoning and problem solving, independent of educational curricula and cultural and/or language background. All second graders will take this 30-minute test, as well as students in grades 3-5 who are new to the district and have not taken a similar test.

If you are the parent of a student who is demonstrating signs of intellectual giftedness, please consult with your child's teacher. We will also administer this test in the month of March to referred students who are strong candidates for identification as Talented and Gifted (TAG)

Math Tip: When you are reading nonfiction look at numbers

- o Talk about number information in charts, maps and graphs
- o Compare amounts, sizes and distances
- o Talk about the information the numbers give you



Reading Tip: Expose your child to nonfiction using newspapers, magazines, online articles and books

- o Talk about captions, sidebars, diagrams, maps, charts and graphs.
- o Look for a particular a fact or section using the table of contents or index.

Dual Immersion Program Updates

Special Event:

- The state of Oregon has recently adopted a Seal of Biliteracy for high school graduates who
 meet criteria for advanced bilingualism and biliteracy.
- Earning the state Seal of Biliteracy on a high school diploma is a very rigorous process.
- In Bend-LaPine, we are creating a pathway for our bilingual and biliterate students, to support them in pursuing the state-level award in high school. Our district pathway will include 5th grade and 8th grade benchmarks.
- On June 9th, we will have a special ceremony to honor our 5th grade Seal of Biliteracy candidates. This special event will be a program-wide Family Night. Save the date—more information coming soon!
