

6th Grade Summer Math Log

Parents and Guardians,

We are asking that all students entering the sixth grade during the **2024 – 2025** school year complete a summer math log. Students are required to log a minimum of 10 hours of math and are encouraged to review any topics previously taught in 5th grade as well as any ideas listed below.

We understand this will require time and effort, however, it is extremely beneficial to keep our math skills sharp over the summer as we move at a rapid pace in 6th grade mathematics. Students may work on any activities listed below.

- Students are required to complete 10 hours of math over summer break
 - This equates to about 1 hour a week
- Students choose from the following categories and keep a log
 - IXL
 - Recommended Skills
 - Retry any 5th grade topics to achieve a score of 100%
 - Work towards meeting 6th grade goals.
 - Khan Academy or a different **academic** website
 - “Cool Math” does **NOT** count
 - Any work with a summer math tutor

Please log any summer math activities below. This log will be submitted to your student’s math teacher by **Friday, August 23, 2024** and counted as the first homework grade. We look forward to working with you!
