Welcome to Marion High School! I will be your students' Mathematics teacher for the 2020-2021 school year. I am excited for this upcoming school year and have high expectations of all my students. I am asking you to help me encourage, motivate, and become an active participant in their education. For students to be successful, they need to attend class regularly, prepared, be willing to learn, cooperate and not be disruptive, study, have a positive attitude, respect me and fellow students, and learn to master the required content. The following is important information needed to know for my class:

#### **Course Description**

This course emphasizes the application of algebraic concepts and skills. State standards will be taught. This is a prerequisite for other mathematics courses. This course is counted as a math elective unit. Students must have seven elective units to achieve a high school diploma. This course will be taught daily for 90 minutes.

Formative: The goal for formative assessments are to monitor student learning to provide ongoing feedback that can be used to improve as needed.

#### Notebooks:

Notebooks are essential to success in math. Notebooks should be a cumulative reflection of your progress in this class. You should keep your notebook throughout the whole course so that you can refer to old problems as needed.

#### Homework:

It is my belief that every student can learn mathematics with the combined efforts of the teacher, the student, and the parent/guardians. Just like any musical instrument or sport or skill, MATH MUST BE PRACTICED. You will not succeed at math by watching someone else do it. Homework gives you the opportunity to practice and refine new skills in math and is therefore important

#### **Quizzes and Tests:**

All major tests will be announced. Quizzes may be announced or unannounced and will assess student understanding on a particular concept. Don't sweat it! If you are keeping up in class, you should be in great shape.

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#### **Expectations for Virtual Learning**

- Check email and Schoology daily
- Submit a completed Acceptable Use Policy (AUP) to your teachers (included in the online registration process)
- Make sure you know how to log into and use your email, Teams, and Schoology
- Create a learning space with no distractions
- Follow recommended schedule when at home
- Cell phones must be put away before the start of classes
- Daily attendance will be monitored during virtual sessions and in-person sessions

#### Calculators:

(Virtual students will use the Wabbitemu app pre-downloaded on their device)

(Face Two Face students) Each student will be assigned a graphing calculator (costing approximately \$100) and will be held responsible for its care and use during their class period. I expect all students to let me know at the beginning of class if their calculator is not in the case, even if they will be using their personal calculator.

#### Dress Code:
