Return your completed application in a sealed envelope to the guidance office by March 31, 2023. Please label the envelope with your name and 'PTSA Scholarship Application'. We will not accept applications after March 31st. There should be five (5) things in your envelope...this application, resume, teacher recommendation, your essay and transcript.

Award requirements:

- Applicant or parent **MUST** be a member of the PTSA for 2022/2023 school year. Deadline to join PTSA for this scholarship is December 1, 2022.
- Applicant must be a graduating senior and have selected a college/university to attend for the fall 2023 school year.
- This application must be signed by your counselor by the March 31, 2023, deadline. Your counselor will provide you a copy of your transcript to include with this application.
- Applicant must provide a resume with a list of all extracurricular activities and student achievements for his/her tenure at Mauldin High School. This can be within school and outside of school.
- Applicant must compose and submit a typed essay answering **BOTH** of the following questions:

Question 1: What are your personal characteristics that make you a good leader?
(Answer in 250-300 words)

Question 2: Tell us how you contribute to the school, community, and/or family in a meaningful way?
(Answer in 250-300 words)

*Essay should be free of grammatical errors and submitted in typed double-space format.

- Applicant must submit one (1) Teacher Recommendation with this application.
