The Board of School Trustees of the Centerville-Abington Community Schools met at 7:00 p.m. in the Spencer Administration Building. The following members were present: Todd Dooley, Todd Duke, Andy Wandersee and Renee Westover. The following member was not present: Brad Lambright. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

Mr. Lung introduced members of the Centerville Senior High School Fine Arts academic team to celebrate their 4th-place finish at state. Mr. Stevenson introduced members of the junior high academic teams for placing 14th in Math, 10th in Social Studies, 3rd in Science, 3rd in English, and 2nd in Interdisciplinary competition at the state meet.

Mr. Hollendonner introduced Mr. Clay Bolser, who is starting as the new athletic director this summer.

Todd Duke opened the floor to community comments.

No one spoke during community comments.

Todd Duke closed the floor to community comments.

Motion by Andy Wandersee, second by Renee Westover to approve the consent items as presented. All members present voted in favor of the motion. Motion passed 4-0. Documentation follows.

Todd Duke thanked the Friends of Morrisson-Reeves Library for a \$100 donation to the Centerville Senior High School French Club. This money will be used to offset costs associated with the European trip in 2025.

Old Business:

Dr. McCoy presented proposals for curriculum materials for the 2024-25 school year for consideration. This is the second reading. Motion by Andy Wandersee, second by Todd Dooley to approve the curriculum materials for the 2024-25 school year as presented. All members present voted in favor of the motion. Motion passed 4-0. Documentation follows.

Dr. McCoy presented proposals for curriculum materials rental and fees for the 2024-25 school year for consideration. This is the second reading. Motion by Renee Westover, second by Andy Wandersee to approve for curriculum materials rental and fees for the 2024-25 school year as presented. All members present voted in favor of the motion. Motion passed 4-0. Documentation follows.



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Dr. McCoy presented a proposal for the CIS agreement for the 2024-25 school year for consideration. Dr. McCoy said the amount listed is the maximum amount that the corporation will have to pay. He said the annual cost is \$64,314.00. Motion by Todd Dooley, second by Renee Westover to approve for the CIS agreement for the 2024-25 school year as presented. All members present voted in favor of the motion. Motion passed 4-0. Documentation follows.

New Business:

Dr. McCoy presented the first reading of new board policies for consideration. He led discussion on the following policies: D175 (Board-Staff Communication), G175 (Chemical Management and Preparedness for Toxic Hazard), G175-R (Chemical Hygiene Plan), G200 (Environmental Health and Safety Issues), G225 (Vehicle Idling), G250 (Pest Control), G250-R, G475 (Prohibition of Unmanned Aircraft), H100 (School Visitors and Parent-Family Engagement), H100-R (School Visitors), H150 (Public Records), H150-E (Request for Personnel File Access), H175 (Questioning of Students), and H200 (Relations with Special Interest Groups). The board will vote on these policies at the next board meeting. No action required.

Dr. McCoy presented the updates on the building projects. He said the cameras at the transportation center are nearly complete. He said maintenance has been working hard on installing the airlines in the building. He said Chomel has completed repairs on the elementary roof. He said they will have their first meeting about the GO bond for the technology and the Annex in June. No action required.

Mr. Stevenson presented an update on support services. The two new buses were delivered on May 21. He invited board members to tour them if they are interested. He said production timelines are still behind. No action required.

Additional Items:

Todd Duke presented an additional employment report. Motion by Renee Westover, second by Todd Dooley to accept the additional employment report. All members present voted in favor of the motion. Motion passed 4-0. Documentation follows.

Dr. McCoy updated the board that the seniors completed their graduation practice today, and they will have their senior breakfast on the last day of school.

Todd Dooley said he is concerned about the additional traffic at Rose Hamilton due to the increased enrollment in Pre-K next year. He suggested adding another route around the building. Mr. Stevenson said that he and Mr. Pritchard started discussing this a couple of months ago when the Pre-K proposal was made. He said they will have to do something in regards to traffic, and they will work on it this summer. Todd Dooley said he would be glad to help in any way.





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Motion by Andy Wandersee, second by Renee Westover to adjourn the meeting. Todd Duke adjourned the meeting at 7:34 p.m. All members present voted in favor of the motion. Motion passed 4-0.
