Summertime brings with it not only a more relaxed pace but also time to read, a favorite pastime of mine. Here are some excellent adult reading books that may enhance your

parenting skills, give you food for thought on a personal basis, or just relax you enough to take you "somewhere else" for a few moments of time.

Night by Elie Wiesel. This is one book you will not be able to put down once you start it. From beginning to end, I sat with rapt attention reading the account of one young man as he endured the Holocaust with his father. This book is highly recommended for teenagers in grade 8 but it was one I found to be particularly insightful for adults as well.

The Power of Now by Eckhart Tolle. Though this book was on the Oprah List it is not why I read it. I happened upon it recently while I was traveling and began a conversation with a fellow traveler. Before I boarded, I had already been to the airport's bookstore and had a copy in hand. This is not a book that you will read from cover to cover in one sitting. 
I have enjoyed serving as PTA President for the last two years. Thank you all for giving me the opportunity to help in some way at the Middle School. Good luck to all of you next year.



THE 2008-2009 THEME is




The six entry categories are:
