

National Black State Troopers Coalition, Inc. Marshall C. Brown Chapter 2019 Scholarship Program 2019 - 2020 College Year

Purpose:

To provide scholarships to three (3) high school graduating seniors intending to pursue a post high school course of study at an accredited college or university. The scholarships will be awarded on a one-time basis for the 2019 - 2020 academic year. Award criteria are academic performance, citizenship and family financial need. Announcement of the awards will be made in July 2019. Scholarships will be presented at the 2019 Annual Marshall C. Brown Chapter's Banquet. The date and location of the banquet will be announced at a later date.

Award Components:

• Three (3) \$1000 scholarships and individual certificates awarded to three (3) graduating senior students selected by the Marshall C. Brown Chapter Education and Scholarship Committee.

Eligibility:

Applications are limited to high school seniors meeting the following qualifications.

- The applicant must be a 2019 High School graduate
- The applicant must show proof of a cumulative average of 85% or higher
- The applicant must be planning on continuing their education on a full time basis in an accredited college or university

*All eligible students may apply without regard to race, religion, color or gender.

Application Process:

Students must complete and submit the following items:

- Completed scholarship application form (if handwritten, please print legibly)
- An official and most recent secondary school transcript with cumulative grade point average and class standing/rank
- Three (3) letters of recommendation from a school guidance counselor, teacher, administrators, coach or employer with significant knowledge of applicant's experience and involvement
- Personal Essay of 250 500 words
- Completed applications are due by **April 1, 2019.** Applications postmarked after this date and/or incomplete applications will not be considered
