1. Open WebBrowser - Log into Lightspeed

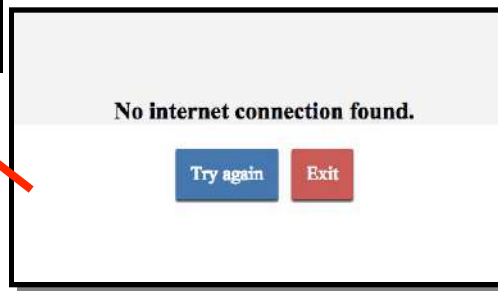



logging into Lightspeed.



If you use an electronic device other than your computer or laptop during the test administration session, your test responses may be invalidated.

You have been given a Student Test Login, scratch paper, and a pencil. Use only the scratch paper that has been provided. Your scratch paper and Student Test Login will be collected at the end of this testing session.

Hold up a Student Test Login ticket and point to the "student name."

Say: Look at your Test Login ticket. Your name should appear on the top line. If you have a ticket for someone other than yourself, please raise your hand now.

Passwords and Access Codes Explained

Type of Password	Utilization	Entered By
★ Student Password*	Used to log the student into the domain specific tests (e.g. Math)	Student
★ Session Access Code	Used to log the student into the appropriate session of the test (e.g. Math 2)	Student
★ Proctor Password**	Used to log the student into the appropriate session (section) of the test if the student began the session, paused for longer than 20 minutes or was inactive for 60 minutes, and needs to resume the session.	Proctor

* Student test password is NOT case sensitive

** Proctor password must be kept confidential.

NOTE: PROCTOR PASSWORD SHOULD ONLY BE USED TO REOPEN A TEST SESSION ON THE SAME DAY




★ Buttons during test: Reset, Pause, Move Back a Question, Forward to Next Question







★ Buttons while on last Question: Reset, Pause, Move Back a Question, Finish Test



★ Copy and Paste: Keyboard commands must be used to Copy and Paste from their Notepad:
 Windows Computer: Copy - Control + C | Paste - Control + V
 Mac Computer: Copy - Command+ C | Paste - Command + V

<div>  <h1>Universal Tools</h1> </div>		
Name	Tool Icon	Description
Guideline		Student uses onscreen tool to assist in reading by raising and lowering tool for each line of text.
Answer Masking		Student hides possible answer choices (multiple choice items only).
Sketch & Highlight		Student may draw using black, red, or blue brushes; highlight; or erase
Notepad		Student may type notes for each particular item

Closing the Test

Steps	Button to Click
On the last item, students click Finish .	
On the test review screen, students click Turn In .	
Below the confirmation question, students click Turn In .	
Student returns to test session selection page and may select the next session or click Exit to exit the client.
