Medical Terminology Children's Book Project

For the Med Term Final Exam you will write and illustrate a children's book using vocabulary from any of the body systems using medical terms and explaining them as you tell the story. Your story should be a typed original children's story. You must use at least 50 medical terms and the book has to be at least 6 pages in length not to include the cover. Be careful to use new words correctly. Be mindful that this is a children's book however it it a medical terminology course, do not put anything inappropriate in the story nor in the pictures.

You must include in your book: 6 separate pages of the story with pictures illustrating what is typed on that page. You should have medical terminology (defined/explained) that flows in the story as well as enhances the story. The story/pages should be colorful and appealing to children.

This assignment is worth (100) 5 (standard based grading) points total. Earn every point you can!!!! So be CREATIVE!
