Objective:

This course will address the cutting-edge fields of filmmaking, photography, and computer graphic arts. Students, through studio projects, investigate the intersection of visual arts, graphics, symbols, and the moving image. An exploration of new techniques and processes will be discussed. Students will receive an introduction to Adobe Photoshop, I-Movie, and Final Cut Express. This course also includes an introduction to Digital Photography.

Supply List:

A flash (thumb) drive for transporting, storing, and backing up work. 2G is acceptable (but you will have to empty work often), 4G is better, and 8G will probably be best when we get to video editing (video files can be huge). **PLEASE MARK THIS WITH YOUR NAME!**
