The Elmwood Music Booster Organization is a group of volunteer members that meet the second Tuesday of every month at 6:30pm in the band room and provide the necessary support, funding, and assistance to aid the various music ensembles and programs here at Elmwood Local Schools. Some examples of their past and present service include:

- Fund-raising for the Music Department
- Purchasing new Band uniforms

• Assisting with fund-raising for music department trips such as field trips and overnight trips

• Assisting with the rental/purchase of Madrigal Dinner and musical costumes

• Offering two scholarships a year; one for a Senior Band Member and one for a Senior Choir Member

- Assisting students with fees for Honors Bands and Choruses
- Providing meals to music students prior to performances and at band camp
- Providing a "Lessons with The Pros" program for beginning band students

• Aiding in the purchase of props, equipment, music, awards, etc. for bands, choirs and musical productions

Elmwood Music Ensembles

The Music ensembles at Elmwood are comprised of approximately 300 members ranging from grades 5-12 and annually hold over 50 performances.

Bands and Choirs at Elmwood:

Middle School Bands and Choirs (Gr. 5-8), Concert Choir (9-12), Concert Band(9-12), Troubadours, Middle School and High School Jazz Bands, Pep Band, and the Elmwood High School Marching Royal Pride.

Special Performance Opportunities:

Many students in grades 7-12 participate in OMEA Solo & Ensemble contest with both solos and ensembles. Many high school and middle school students have applied for or auditioned into and participated in various Honors Choruses and Honors Bands such as OMEA District I, University of Toledo, BGSU Sight Reading Clinic and Choruses, Owen's Community College, Ohio All-State Choir, Ohio Choral Directors' Association, American Choral Directors' Association, and All-Ohio State Fair Youth Choir and Band.
