Greetings MJH Parents/Guardians-

During the month of April, Memorial will begin the process of implementing our state AIR assessments to students. **Due to the nature of the test and the technology required to give them, students will only be able to take their AIR assessment in the building.**

**Due to the need to provide social distancing for testing, our testing schedule will run on an A-L and an M-Z schedule.** Please review the following bullet points carefully as to what this means for your child:

- Your child will **ONLY** report to school on the days they have testing scheduled. **Please DO NOT** send your child to school on days they are not testing.
- If your child is not scheduled to test on a testing day, your child will be remote **AND** asynchronous during the observed testing times.
- Once testing is over, we will be following an adjusted building schedule (this information is included below). **For those students who are remote/asynchronous on a non-testing day, they will log into Schoology and join their classes live for the rest of their scheduled class periods.**
  - On ELA testing days, students who are not testing will be asynchronous from 8:30-10:30AM.
  - On Math and Science testing days, students who are not testing will be asynchronous from 8:30-10:15AM.

For some, this may be the first time that your child comes to the school building for testing. If this is the case, please carefully read the following bullet points:

- **For students that have been remote learning and come for testing, we are asking that you make plans to pick up your child once testing is completed. Please see the transportation information below if you would like to utilize this as a means of transportation for your child.**
- If you are unable to pick up your child once testing is completed, **your child will report to the new gym and finish their school day by following their schedule using Schoology.**
- Lunch will be provided to your child in the event they are not able to go home after testing.



### Transportation Information:

Transportation will be available to students who are coming to Memorial to take the AIR tests that are currently remote students. For Memorial, we will have 3 busses going to multiple locations for pick-up and drop off of students for AIR testing. Please review the following bullet points carefully regarding transportation for remote students to come to the building for AIR testing:

#### First Bus Routes:

- Quarry Park: Arrives at 7:30AM; drop off at 10:55AM.
- Front of Adrian on Homestead: Arrives at 7:35AM; drop off at 10:50AM.

#### Second Bus Routes:

- Front of Sunview on Meadow Wood: Arrives at 7:25AM; drop off at 10:55AM.
- Lyndhurst Community Center Parkview: Arrives at 7:30AM; drop off at 11:00AM.
- Anderson Field: Arrives at 7:35AM; drop off at 11:05AM.

#### Third Bus Routes:

- Front of Bexley Park-Wrenford: Arrives at 7:30AM; drop off at 10:55AM.
- Front of Rowland on Bayard: Arrives at 7:35AM; drop off at 10:55AM.

### **Memorial Junior High Spring 2021 AIR Testing Schedule:**

7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade ELA Testing Schedule: ELA testing is in 2 parts. Students will need to report for **BOTH** days of testing (8:30-10:30AM):

- 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> grade: A-L Part 1: 4/7; Part 2: 4/8
- 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> grade: M-Z Part 1: 4/9; Part 2: 4/12
- ***If your child is not assigned to test on a testing day, your child will be asynchronous during testing times and remote for that testing day.***

7<sup>th</sup> Math Testing Schedule: Math testing is in 2 parts. Students will need to report for **BOTH** days of testing (8:30-10:15AM):

- 7<sup>th</sup> grade: A-L: Part 1: 4/13; Part 2: 4/14
- 7<sup>th</sup> grade: M-Z: Part 1: 4/15; Part 2: 4/16
- ***If your child is not assigned to test on a testing day, your child will be asynchronous during testing times and remote for that testing day.***



8<sup>th</sup> Math Testing Schedule: Math testing is in 2 parts. Students will need to report for **BOTH** days of testing: (8:30-10:15AM):

- 8<sup>th</sup> grade: A-L Part 1: 4/20; Part 2: 4/21
- 8<sup>th</sup> grade: M-Z Part 1: 4/22; Part 2: 4/23
- ***If your child is not assigned to test on a testing day, your child will be asynchronous during testing times and remote for that testing day.***

8<sup>th</sup> Science Testing Schedule: Math testing is in 2 parts. Students will need to report for **BOTH** days of testing (8:30-10:15AM):

- 8<sup>th</sup> grade: A-L Part 1: 4/13; Part 2: 4/14
- 8<sup>th</sup> grade: M-Z Part 1: 4/15; Part 2: 4/16
- ***If your child is not assigned to test on a testing day, your child will be asynchronous during testing times and remote for that testing day.***
