

Memory Makers

For this assignment, you are going to Interview an [older] family member. [If you're worried about Social Distancing, go old school and use a phone. Wild idea, you're welcome.]

Below you will find a few guiding questions to help you along in your discussion. Don't feel limited by these ideas. Think of them as a starting off point.



- *How has photography changed in their lifetime?*
- *Have them choose a photo that is meaningful to them*
 - *Interview them about the photo*
 - *Why did they choose this photo?*
 - *Who is in the photo? Relationship to them?*
 - *Where is the photo stored? Why?*
 - *Does the photo remind them of a memory?*
 - *What is the memory?*

When you're done, include:

- A brief description of who you interviewed and why you chose them
- A photo of the photo [you can use your phone] they were talking about
- A question/answer style write up.
- Conclusion: what did you learn from this discussion? How will it guide you in your future as a photographer?
