Returning to School

Beginning Oct. 5, all face-to-face students will return to school. To minimize possible COVID outbreaks, MES is committed to providing a safe learning environment given the circumstances. We will continue to wear masks in grades 3-5, clean and disinfect our school and encourage our students to social distance. Classrooms will be set up in "pods" of 2-4 students and these students will sit together in every class to minimize the chances of coming in contact with a positive case.

COVID-19 Information

Students with a fever should not come to school. We will continue to check temperatures int the morning and throughout the day. We will send home anyone with a fever of 99.6 or higher. Any students, who are sent home with a fever or stay home because of a fever, should not return to school until they are fever free without medication for 24 hours. This will be strictly enforced this year.

Students who have been in close contact with someone who shows signs of COVID or has tested positive for COVID should not come to school and the parents should contact the school. This is very important in the effort to keep MES open and safe!
