## Treasurer's Report - Jaime Gostkowski

- See attached report highlighted is current activity
- Membership +80 new including 16 staff \$5002.90
  - Paid State dues
- Around the World in One Night budget for OHES & VES was combined made \$5065.35
  - Great considering the current climate
- Parent Donation \$122 Amazon Smile + \$125 community vendor + \$5 staff donation
- Spirit Wear +\$313.98 sales from ATWION and online
- Expenses
  - \$4500 VES field trips
    - Field trip budget can be divided differently if wanted
  - \$92 kickballs bought for OHES recess
  - Carryover from last year for Rosy Revere (approved last year, spent this year)
- \$3800 OHES and \$2600 VES grants left
  - \$100 year end Potluck for paper products and desserts
  - o \$300 Diatlo grant
  - Experiential theatre production Apr 27 VES and Apr 28 OHES
- Jaime asked if anyone had any questions none

#### K-4 Math & Science Supervisor - Ms. Glover

- Grants will be coming
  - Bring back courtyard in center of VES
    - Reached out to Hopewell to find out costs of their revamp \$60000!!!
    - Reached out to Nektar since has experience with schools and grants
      - Has \$1500 design fee

- Will look into if can put fee towards purchase of plants
- If have a design is a lot easier to ask for donations from companies (J&J, Jansen, etc)
- Have reached out to local nurseries but not great feedback
- How will this be used in the curriculum?
  - Native plants so will learn about the ecosystems, plants, animals and dynamics (3<sup>rd</sup> grade)
  - Structure and function 4<sup>th</sup> grade
  - Place for mindfulness center and social-emotional learning
  - Outdoor classroom from Eagle Scout needs to be 2ft longer
- Highschool had grant last year for a nice garden
- Girl Scout troop did plant a garden and are in touch
- Water filling stations already approved so don't need grant!
  - 2 per school
- o Family Math Night usually +300 people attend but need to cancel the night event
  - Will make it an online event with kids making videos to show what to do at home
    - Allows the kids who have worked hard towards this to still have a moment to shine
  - Will add a blurb in the PTA newsletter and email will go out to the volunteers
    - Volunteers are 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> graders selected to play math games at lunch and then will help with the games during the night

#### Mom's Night Out - Yuna Kim

- Last year did wood painting
- This year not planning a large group even due to the current uncertainty
- Will re-evaluate next year

#### Around the World in One Night – Alex Clark

- Thank you for all of the support
- Everything went well despite the anxiety
- Attendance was down by half
- Combined the two events by having the country posters from VES
  - Need to re-evaluate to increase VES participation
- 13 country rooms thank you!
- Custodian feedback was positive
- Teacher feedback 1 teacher's supplies were used Alex will take care of
- Uneaten food was redistributed to the custodians, high school helpers and police station
  - Nothing was wasted
  - Cookies went to staff
- Meghna and Alex will not be running it again next year need chairs
- Should ask parents for any photos/videos they took to make a short promotional video that teachers can show to the classes
