Strategic Plan Goal: 4- Continuous Growth- All Students, All Subjects

Outcome: A: Increased percentage of students demonstrating proficiency on standards C: Increased growth rate for students experiencing personal and/or systemic barriers to achievement or opportunity

Academic Gap Goal: Work to close the discrepancy margins in math found for students in each grade level from our Hispanic population performing in the low-risk category compared to all students at Meadows. Overall, 76% of our Hispanic student population is performing at low risk compared to 83% of the remaining student body performing at low risk.

Actions:

- Grade level teachers utilize PD with district math coach with a focus on increasing math fluency and number sense.
- Designated PLC dates focused on math instruction and progress.
- Regular grade level data team meetings to review student progress and make intervention adjustments as needed.
- Ensure students have multiple opportunities within a lesson to practice skills individually and in small group

Strategic Plan Goal: 2 – Responsible, Resilient, Empowered Learners

Outcome: A: Increased percentage of students meeting social, emotional, and behavioral expectations.

Strategic Plan Goal 3: Critical Thinkers and Solution Seekers

Outcome B: Increased percentage of students applying learning to collaboratively engage in solving relevant challenges within the classroom, school, and community.

Behavioral or SEL Gap Goal: We will decrease the risk ratio for students receiving an office referral for students identifying as Pacific Islander from a risk ratio of 2.05 to 1.25 or less.

Actions:

- Continued use of restorative circles and restorative language when problem solving conflict with key stakeholders.
- Check in, Check out system in place for students as tier 2 support.
- SEL lunch groups to increase pro-social relationships between students.
- Strengthen PBIS structures and interventions to enhance the positive and inclusive culture at Meadows.
- Foster attitudes and behaviors that are aware of bias, free of ridicule/intimidation, and that affirm an appreciation of cultural differences.
- Recognize and celebrate improvements in students social-emotional skills and academic achievement at the student, grade and school level.
