

# Free SAT/ACT Test Prep through Libby!

The North Lake County Public Library has free access to **Method Test Prep**, which includes SAT & ACT study help with unlimited retakes, full length practice exams, quizzes, assessment tests, vocabulary exercises, review packets, and more.

All you need is a North Lake County Public Library card. If you are not currently a card holder, you can fill out a short form for a temporary digital card. Simply go to [https://mtsc.ent.sirsi.net/client/en\\_US/MTSC/](https://mtsc.ent.sirsi.net/client/en_US/MTSC/) and click on the link below “Digital Card” on the bottom left. After the form is submitted, access is immediate!

For a physical, permanent card, you can visit the library and bring a photo ID and proof of MT residency (a driver’s license, learner’s permit, or a school ID will satisfy both requirements). Parental permission is not required for persons fifteen years and older.

1. Download the Libby app from the Apple or Google Play app store on your tablet or phone, or go to [libbyapp.com](http://libbyapp.com) on your computer
2. Follow the prompts to find your local library and then you can create an account with just your library card number or temporary card number
3. Scroll down the homepage to the Extras section depicted below



4. Select the Method Test Prep tab and click “Get” to be redirected to a confirmation page. After confirming, you will have 30 days of unlimited access. Access can be renewed just as easily after the 30 day window
