

Michael D. Priddy Health Sciences Scholarship

The Michael D. Priddy Health Sciences Scholarship was established by family and friends to recognize and honor his retirement as Superintendent of Pitt County Schools. The scholarship, which will be given annually, will be awarded to a Pitt County High School Senior who plans a career in a health science field at Pitt Community College. The scholarship amount may vary from year to year and the award will be paid directly to Pitt Community College. The scholarship will be awarded on the following criteria:

1. The student must plan to major in a health science field at Pitt Community College.
2. The student must be on track for curriculum completion requirements for the Pitt County Schools Health Sciences Academy.
3. The student must have a weighted GPA of 3.0 or above.
4. The student must have a minimum of 100 hours documented volunteer service.

Financial need shall be a consideration. The selection committee will be composed of Dr. Priddy and his designees. The selection committee will have the responsibility of selecting the recipient and their selection will be the final decision.
