 - T: Count out 3 more cubes. Now you have 16 cubes. Write the number 16 on your mat.

Topic C: Decompose Numbers 11-20, and Count to Answer "How Many?" Questions in Varied Configurations

- T: Put one more cube in your circle. Write the number on your mat to tell me how many cubes there are now.
