**PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:**

Summer school services have historically been a key element of Migrant Education Program (MEP) design. It is the most appropriate time to provide clear supplemental services to MEP students, and provides the opportunity for extended learning time to fill the gaps caused by the students' mobility and the disruption of the school year.

**POSITION SUMMARY**

The classroom teacher performs under supervision of the program administrator or other designated supervisor, and has major responsibility for the instruction and supervision of students. Instruction of students will include individual skill development, expansion of knowledge, and development of ability to reason. Supervision of students including guidance, development and safety. The classroom teacher functions in accordance with the established policies, rules, regulations and the performance standards of the District/State and the performance goals established for the teacher.

Compensation at \$39.00 an hour.

- Valid Oregon Elementary teaching license. Bilingual (Eng./Span) Preferred.
- Prior experience working with diverse and bilingual students and families and the ability to develop curriculum to meet the needs of students who migrate with their families due to agricultural work and support access to meet high academic state standards in reading and/or math in an integrated way.
- Ability to develop hands-on, thematic units for students in the areas of reading and math.
- Can develop units that both accelerate and enrich student achievement through the integration of science, technology and arts.
- Ability to provide leadership to teachers in the development of pre and post formative assessment to demonstrate student growth in the areas of reading and math.
- Experience working with a diverse population of students.
- Genuine enjoyment and understanding of a diverse population of children and families including students with varied linguistic and social needs.
- Ability to establish and maintain effective, professional relationships and work in harmony with other staff, supervisors, parents, students, and general public.
- Ability to perform within district and program policies, procedures, and guidelines.
