Reading/Writing: In reading, students are learning about cause and effect. We read different types of texts and students will identify and discuss the cause and effect sequence within the text. In writing, we are working on comparing and contrasting. We will spend the next few weeks reading articles, completing a Venn diagram, and writing essays. I am meeting with reading groups each day. Please encourage your student to read each night at home. The public library is a great place to access some interesting reading material.

Math: In the beginning of December, we will take a test on division. We will then spend the remaining time before break reviewing multiplication, factors, multiples, and any other foundational skills students need. I meet with math groups throughout the week. Those students will work on skills, strategies, and standards that they need to master. Please help your child work on addition, subtraction, and multiplication facts.

Social Studies: In social studies, we will discuss and analyze primary and secondary sources. We will also begin learning about the people and history of Ohio.
