I believe we have turned the corner and now have our eyes set on spring-like temperatures and the sights and sounds of Laker spring activities. Nonetheless, we have a cluttered May schedule filled with back-to-backs, and multiple event weeks. Summer Recreation Returns in June

Please register your child for the grade they <u>are</u> currently in for the 23-24 school year. We are looking forward to another fun-filled summer for our area youth. Please read through all of the information carefully before registering. Students will be signing up for a 4-week program, four days a week. Students will rotate through all of the activities weekly.

The following are descriptions of the basic program's sporting and enrichment activities.

Arts & Crafts: Students will be given a wide variety of opportunities at their level to learn about the arts and express themselves through the Arts, along with doing some fun arts and crafts.

Cooking Fun: Students will cook various foods, from cooking on the stove to microwave cooking. Students will enjoy making a variety of quick healthy snacks that they will be able to safely make on their own.

Baseball, Softball & Tee Ball: These activities are included in the basic program. Each student is scheduled to have this activity every day and work on the fundamentals of the game and play games.

Swimming Fun: Participants will learn various swimming games and activities to promote a healthy lifestyle. They will engage in activities on an individual basis and work with others. Please bring your swimsuit, towel, and plastic bag. Goggles are optional.

Football, basketball, Soccer, Tennis, and Volleyball: In these activities, students will receive instruction on the skill of these sports and have a chance to play games. Modified equipment will be used by 1st, 2nd, and 3rd graders, so they will have some degree of success.

Summer 2023 Waska Power & Wellness

What: Weight room portion will consist of full body training each day, using principles and philosophies of the Tier System and Alternating Linear Periodization. We will use 6 foundational movement patterns (Squat, Hinge, Press, Pull, Jumping, and Throwing), and other auxiliary movements for Mobility and Core work. All weight lifting exercises will be age and skill appropriate and will be modified as needed.

We will also do Speed, Acceleration, Agility, and Plyometric exercises each week. The purpose of this program is to increase our overall athleticism by enhancing our strength, linear speed, agility, and power. We will be utilizing Google Classroom to send out weight room workouts for grades 9-12. So please use your school issued Gmail account, and bring your personal device to each workout. Grades 7 & 8 will use a general template that will be projected on the TV screen.

Why: This program is a great way for you to increase your own physical health and wellness. It is a great way to increase your athletic ability. 

For "Lifeguard Training" The instructor will contact you and send you the link for the online course on or near May 1st. You must show that you completed the online portion in order to complete the in class portion.

** There will also be 10-16 hours of online classes. The blended learning format allows the student to work independently on theory utilizing informational videos and tutorials. Then it combines that online knowledge acquisition with in-person water, First Aid, and CPR/AED hands-on skills training.

Driver's Education -Virtual Option Available

Central Lakes Driving School is offering a virtual Driver's Education class. Each class we host will be online via Zoom and our web-based learning software. Students need to be present on Zoom all 10 days of the class. This is a State approved course for any student in MN.

This is not a Minnewaska community education class.

Online class only cost: \$160

Class will guide students through 30 hours of content asynchronously (self-paced). You will need to sign up for behind-the-wheel lessons to complete the process and get your license. A certificate will be emailed to you immediately after class is over for this purpose.

Behind-the-wheel only cost: \$450

This is for students under 18 who took their drivers ed classroom with a different driving school. Behind the wheel sessions are 2 hours long and depart from the Alexandria office.

Combination package cost: \$498

This includes the 30 hours of classroom and 6 hours of behind-the-wheel requirement for anyone under age 18 in Minnesota OR Online Class + Behind-The-Wheel Lessons with Payment Installments \$235 down (\$300 later). The additional \$300 will be due when you book your BTW lessons (total \$535).

There are no in-person classes offered at this time.

Note: The state-approved online course will guide students through 30 hours of content asynchronously (self-paced). They can start and stop according to when it works best for their schedule. They will have up to 6 months to complete the course. The quickest it can usually be done is about 2-3 weeks.

Behind-the-wheel lessons are 2 hours long and depart from our office at 1417 Broadway St, Alexandria, MN.

Girls Youth Basketball K-5 Camp
