 - UD Concessions – basketball is complete and many thanks to our volunteers this season; potential for additional dates during the WGI Worlds the weekends of April 7th and 15th; looking for a replacement chair for next year to coordinate the games and volunteers. Thank you Tracey for all your hard work this season!
 - Winter Invitational – Cindy was not able to join the meeting and asked Jenna to provide her thanks to the many volunteers that made the event a success, which includes all the volunteers who filled in the slots that day, Jenna for leading the day, Anne and Emily for concessions, Joy for the hospitality room, Tamara for the programs, Mike Hill and the Pit Dads for the logistics, Todd Charlesworth for coordinating the baked goods, Mary for the candy grams, the medical team, Todd Dudley for use of the radios and Mr. Foster and Mr. Hann for use of the facilities and custodial staff!

- SCRIP – reported sales and rebates up for February; rebates for February were \$883 with a YTD of \$2,125
