- I. Called to order at 4:38 pm.
- II. Due to a slight mix up the minutes from the December 16th meeting were unavailable.
- III. Review of classroom furniture for Pre-K through 2nd grade classrooms and the art room.
 1. Reviewed and confirmed furniture choices/colors for all the Pre-K through 2nd grade classrooms. Chairs, stools, tables, lecterns, storage pieces and soft seating were all considered. Color palette consists of neutrals plus blue, orange, yellow and green. A variety of tables and seating options have been chosen for each classroom.
 2. Reviewed furniture choices/colors for the Art Room. Tables and stools were selected for student work areas. The stools offer flexible foot placement to meet the needs of all students. A teaching space was also selected with a puzzle table and a lectern with an orange top to add a pop of color.
- IV. Library furniture
 1. Soft seating options were reviewed and discussed, which would create two relaxed seating areas for students. Two sway chairs were chosen for adult seating. Fusions tables were selected for the stem spaces/exploration area/flex space. Many mobile book carts will be present through out

the library. Furniture from the Coffin School computer lab will be reused in the new lab at Kate Furbish.

- V. The Kate Furbish Wallcovering Proofs were also shared. Ariana will reach out to the art committee to review and get feedback on the Wallcoverings.
