Kathy Sieck Chase will be Business Manager and Custodian of funds to invest and re-invest funds for the McIntosh School District. Kathy Sieck Chase is administrator of Trust/Agency accounts. The Board President or Vice Chairman along with the Business Manager will sign General, Special Education, Capital Outlay, Food Service, Early Retirement, Enterprise, Scholarship, and Capital Project checks and contracts; plus all necessary forms for the McIntosh School District.
