Authors' names in text

Others like Wellek and Warren (310-15) hold an opposite point of view.

Authors' names in reference

Others hold an opposite point of view (e.g., Wellek and Warren 310-150).

Author's name in text

It may be true, as Robertson maintains, that "in the appreciation of medieval art the attitude of the observer is of primary importance..." (136).

Citing two or more works by the same author

"Hamlet is a play in which poison is the dominant metaphor..." (Mack, "The Poisoned Kingdom" 15).

Note: To cite two or more works by the same author(s), put a comma after the last name of the author (s) and add the title of the work if brief {if not a shortened version} and the relevant pagereference. If you state the author(s) name in the text, give only the title and page reference.
