Additional important notes

Combination locks

MMS provides all of our students with 2 combination locks (for hallway and Physical Education lockers). Personal locks are not permitted. Please do not purchase or send your own lock! 6th graders will get plenty of time to practice on their locks during the first weeks of school/orientation!

Agenda books

A small calendar/agenda book is a great additional supply for all students to help keep organized!

Chrome books/personal devices

Please bring your chromebook from your previous year of school. If you are new to MMS, you will be issued a chrome book. Students are NOT permitted to bring personal devices (laptops, tablets, etc.)

Only school-issued chrome books may be used.

MMS Backpack Policy

As you will see in the MMS student handbook that will be shared with our students and caregivers at the start of the school year, students at MMS are not permitted to carry backpacks as this crowds classrooms (*for medical exemptions, contact our Nurse Shook at gshook@somsd.k12.nj.us).

Backpacks remain stored in lockers during the school day and there are designated time frames for children to go to their lockers midday. Children may carry a small drawstring bag to take to Physical Education class, and/or small purses. As you purchase school items, think about what items your child can carry with them easily between their classes.

We discourage large backpacks with wheels as lockers are narrow.
