We are pleased to advise you that the Monroe-Union Breakfast Rotary Club will once again be awarding scholarships to worthy Union County high school seniors. These scholarships are to be awarded based on the applicant's credentials in the area of service to people, the community and the environment. These are not academic or need-based scholarships.

The MUBRC scholarships are open scholarships and may be awarded to any senior student in good standing at his/her school who will be continuing their education past graduation in a recognized school.

The Monroe-Union Breakfast Rotary Club will choose one student from each school based on an essay submitted to the club. The application form is attached to this letter. There is no limit to the number of students that may apply. All we ask is that they write an essay of 250-300 words answering the question: "What have you done in the area of service to people, the community and the world to deserve this scholarship?" The essays are to be returned no later than February 9, 2022. At that time, you are requested to mail the completed essays to the above address with the application forms or they can be emailed to bleckey2@gmail.com. Please do not include high school academic transcripts.

The MUBRC will then review the essays and select one student from each school to visit our club and make a 10 minute presentation on their service

work. You are also invited to attend. We will advise the names of the students and the club visit dates in February.

After all nominees have been to visit our club, the MUBRC scholarship committee will determine the awards to be presented at our annual awards banquet on May 12. You, your students and their parents are invited to be our guests for the evening.

We are excited about this program and work diligently in community efforts to financially support the program.
