Scholarship Program

Since 1983, the Monroe-Union Breakfast Rotary Club has awarded more than \$265,000 in scholarships to more than 340 Union County college bound high school seniors. In 2023, our club awarded \$16,000 to 12 students.

These scholarships are based on the Rotary International Motto "Service Above Self".

The objective of these awards is to recognize students for their service to the community, the environment and the world. Academics, need or sports prowess are not considered. It is our intent to foster and encourage these students to continue their "Service Above Self" activities for the rest of their lives.

The process will be similar to previous years. A brief essay will be required followed by an in-person speech to the club by the finalists, as determined from the essay.

******NOTE**** A MINIMUM OF THREE APPLICANTS PER SCHOOL MAY BE REQUIRED FOR THE SCHOOL TO BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE**

 - January 3-5, 2024 – Applications delivered to schools and available online at www.monroebreakfastrotary.org
 - January 31, 2024 – Essays are due back by mail or email
 - February 19, 2024 – Notification of finalists begins with invitations to speak to the club in person.
 - May 2024 – Scholarships and Awards Banquet -students, parents, counselors invited. The amount of each students' award will be announced.
