• New students consistently arriving. Most new students are identified as ELL students. Our population is transient so overall enrollment figures remain relatively consistent with a population ranging between 230-235 students. Students move out of the district or transition to charter schools. Grade 4 teacher can only identify 25% of her students starting here in kindergarten. Additional information was sought on mid-year student emergency forms that were sent home for updated contact information asked the status of student preschool experience. This information will be added to our data inventory.
