#### Trustees' Leadership Scholarship Benefits and Expectations

#### Scholarship Benefits:

- Trustee Scholars are directly admitted into the Mott Honors College and must enroll in an Honors-section of ENGL 101 for the Fall Semester immediately following high school graduation. There are two exceptions: (a) if the student has already completed ENGL 101 or (b) they are placed into a developmental English courses. In the case of these exceptions, Trustee Scholars must enroll in at least one Honors course for Fall Semester (e.g. ENGL 102, ART 110)
- The first year of the Trustees' Scholarship can be applied toward MCC tuition and fees for up to 31 credits of Fall, Winter and/or Summer courses.
- A second year of the Trustees' Scholarship will be awarded if—at the conclusion of the first academic year—the student's grade point average is 2.75 or higher.
- For students awarded a second year, the total scholarship may not exceed a total of 62 credits for the first and second years combined. Although strongly encouraged, enrollment in Summer courses is not a requirement.

#### Scholarship Expectations:

- Trustee Scholars must be registered for Fall classes at Mott by June 28, 2020 or the scholarship will be awarded to an alternate high school student.
- Trustee Scholars must attend the Trustee Scholars Night scheduled on Monday, August 24, 2020. Tickets will be provided to the Trustee Scholar and two guests.
- Trustee Scholars are required to enroll full-time (i.e., 12 credits or more) for both Fall and Winter semesters.
- Trustee Scholars placed into developmental courses must enroll in those courses during Summer and/or Fall Semester in the first year of the scholarship.

Note: Mott Community College would like to have all Trustee Scholars complete a degree in two years. Hence, recipients are encouraged to **fully utilize the tuition and fees** provided for under this scholarship.
