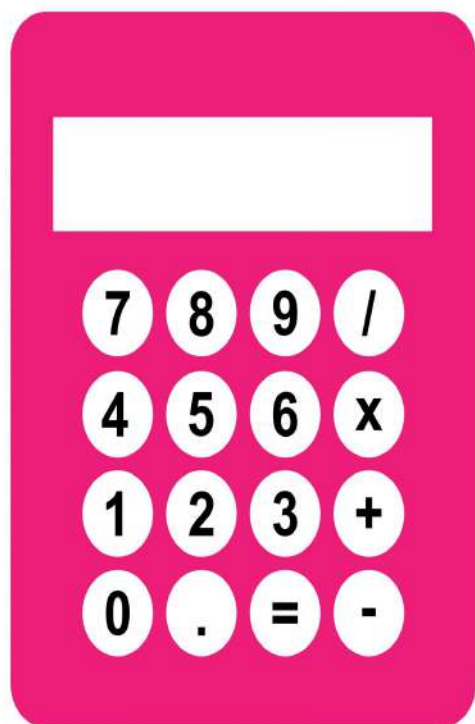

# Grading Policies

In class assignments will be given every day. Most nights a suggested assignment will be given as well. Suggested assignments are not required and will not be graded. However, each person that completes the suggested assignment will get a check for completing it. This assignment should be used as practice and preparation for any upcoming assessment.

As mentioned earlier, after each standard, a checkpoint will occur. This will be a graded assignment for correctness. Problems on the checkpoints will come from the suggested assignments. Checkpoints will be recorded in the assignment (40%) category.

A quiz will be given over 2-3 standards. Quizzes will be graded for correctness and recorded in the assessment (60%) category.

Tests will be given at the end of each unit. Each test could be made up of multiple choice and/or short answer. Students will be expected to show and submit work to assess misunderstanding. Tests will be recorded in the assessment (60%) category.
