Students will receive a grade daily.

Late work will not be accepted.

Students have three days to turn in absent work. Tests/Quizzes will be given throughout the course to assess student understanding. You will be notified in advance of a unit test. Unexcused absences will result in a zero for the daily grade.

Class work will be graded for completeness, but may be graded for correctness as needed. Checkpoints will occur after each standard. These checkpoints will go in the assignment category for correctness.

Following each lesson there will be a suggested assignment students may complete to prepare for the checkpoints.

Grading Policies



In class assignments will be given every day. Most nights a suggested assignment will be given as well. Suggested assignments are not required and will not be graded. However, each person that completes the suggested assignment will get a check for completing it. This assignment should be used as practice and preparation for any upcoming assessment.

As mentioned earlier, after each standard, a checkpoint will occur. This will be a graded assignment for correctness. Problems on the checkpoints will come from the suggested assignments. Checkpoints will be recorded in the assignment (40%) category.

A quiz will be given over 2-3 standards. Quizzes will be graded for correctness and recorded in the assessment (60%) category.

Tests will be given at the end of each unit. Each test could be made up of multiple choice and/or short answer. Students will be expected to show and submit work to assess misunderstanding. Tests will be recorded in the assessment (60%) category.
