

Mr. MacConnell's Lesson plans

While out, each student has been provided worksheets and news articles that they are to complete and turn in when they return to school. These packets of work are individualized but contain assignments like:

- Timed reading fluency practice (Read Naturally)
- Current News articles with questions
- Grammar practice
- Math worksheets/practice

In addition, students can also use this time outside of school to practice math facts and read independently. Below are a few suggestions of how you can support their practice of these fundamental skills:

Math

Reading

- <https://www.overdrive.com/> - with a library card and a device, rent books from your library right to your device (audio books, picture books, read-to-me books, etc.)

Social Skills

- Cook together – cooking together provides valuable skills, especially when it involves a recipe.
- Play a board or card game together.
- Watch a movie together and discuss it afterwards
