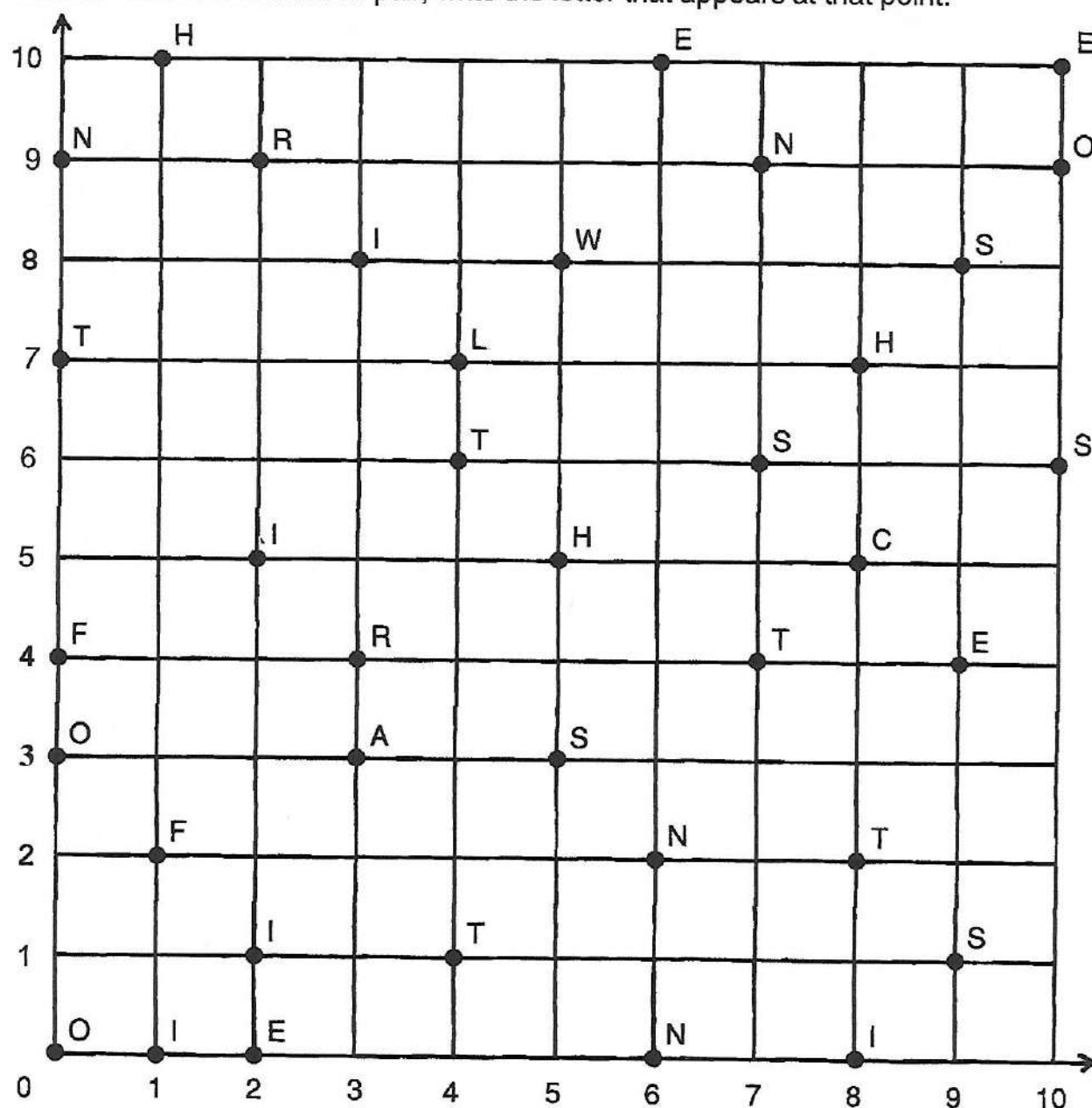


Which Skier Won the Norway-to-Finland Cross-Country Ski Race?
