To Kill A Mockingbird Unit Two-Week Plan:

Day 1: Read and highlight pages 7-9 of the unit packet. Read Chapter 5 of the novel. If the students want to listen to an audiobook recording of the novel, there are many options on YouTube.

Day 2: Read Chapter 6 of the novel. Read and highlight page 10 in the unit packet.

Day 3: Read Chapter 7 of the novel. Begin the Chapters 1-11 Study Guide on pages 12-13 of the unit packet. The students need to answer the Personal Response Question and the 5 study guide questions. The students do not need to complete the Literature and Writing Assignments at the bottom of page 13.

Day 4: Read Chapter 8 of the novel. Continue the Chapters 1-11 Study Guide on pages 12-13 of the unit packet.

Day 5: Read Chapter 9 of the novel. Continue the Chapter 1-11 Study Guide on pages 12-13 of the unit packet.

Day 6: Read Chapter 10 of the novel. Continue the Chapters 1-11 Study Guide on pages 12-13 of the unit packet.

Day 7: Read Chapter 11 of the novel. This is the last chapter of Part I of the book. Finish the Chapters 1-11 Study Guide on pages 12-13 of the unit packet.

Day 8: Read and highlight page 14 of the unit packet ("Before You Read Chapters 12-21" Nonfiction Selection). Read Chapter 12 of the novel.

Day 9: Read Chapter 13 of the novel. Begin the Chapters 12-21 Study Guide on pages 16-17 of the unit packet. The students need to answer the Personal Response Question and the 5 study guide questions. The students do not need to complete the Literature and Writing Assignments at the bottom of page 17.

Day 10: Read Chapter 14 of the novel. Continue the Chapters 1-11 Study Guide on pages 12-13 of the unit packet.

Public Speaking Unit Two-Week Plan:

- Day 1: These students have completed their final drafts and notecards for the Admiration Speech. The students will begin presenting these speeches when we return to school. I am asking the students to practice their speech using their notecards each day for the next two weeks. Read and highlight pages 1-3 of the Speaking Ethically Unit Packet.
- Day 2: Continue to practice the Admiration Speech using the speech notecards. Read and highlight pages 4-5 of the Speaking Ethically Unit Packet.
- Day 3: Continue to practice the Admiration Speech using the speech notecards. Read and highlight pages 6-7 of the Speaking Ethically Unit Packet.
- Day 4: Continue to practice the Admiration Speech using the speech notecards. Read and highlight page 8 of the Speaking Ethically Unit Packet.
- Day 5: Continue to practice the Admiration Speech using the speech notecards. Read and answer the prompt on page 9 of the Speaking Ethically Unit Packet.
