

MS Dogs Set Records at Quinter By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Middle School boys track team placed fourth overall out of 12 teams competing at the Quinter Track Meet on April 29. The worked together for a total of 58 points.

Eighth grader Dylan Wark set a new school record for the third time this season in the 800m run at 2:14.39. He had set the record at the first meet of the season in Logan and again at the Hill City meet earlier in the week. Wark also placed second in the 100m hurdles at 16.10 and third in high jump at 5' 0". He was a member of the 4 x 400m relay team setting a new school record of 4:28.15 along with Ezekiel Weiner, Diego Perez, and Roberto Araux. They broke the record of 4:38.1 set by Corey Shaw, Justin Dice, Isaac Broeckelman, and Jeremy Hunter in 2006. This is the third middle school boys event to set a new record this season.

Diego Perez placed first in the 1600m run at 5:30.66. He was second in Triple Jump at 34' 9.5" and third in Long Jump at 16' 1". Ezekiel Weiner placed fifth in 3200m (13:24.60) and ran the 1600m in 6:21.32. Roberto Araux placed fourth in 200m hurdles (32.38), fifth in 100m hurdles (19.07), and tried high jump for the first time this season jumping 4' 2". The 4 x 100m Relay team of Tanner Black, Javier Romero, Cristian Garcia, and Tannor Todd finished in 1:10.60,

Tanner Black set a PR in the 200m of 28.71, ran the 400m in 1:08.99, and Long Jumped 9' 9". Tannor Todd set a PR of 47' 9" in Discus, threw the Shot Put 14' 11", and Long Jumped 9' 7". Javier Romero set a PR of 21' 2" in Shot Put and threw the Discus 51' 4.5". Cristian Garcia ran the 100m in 19.03 seconds, threw the Shot 21' 2.5" and the Discus 48' 11". Owen Amlong ran the 200m in 40.24 and the 400m in 1:43.27.

The Dogs continued their season on May 3 in Logan.
