Grades will be calculated upon the following weighted categories:

Concert Attendance 40%
Daily Participation 35%
Written Assignments/Quizzes/Moodle 25%

Concert Attendance Policy

Members of choirs are expected and required to attend and participate in all scheduled and related events. Please note the following excused exceptions:

If an absence is the result of: 1) Personal illness or injury 2) Death in the family 3) An event (such as a family wedding or family graduation) it will be counted as an excused absence.

Not all absences are excused. Unexcused absences will receive a zero for the concert grade.

If it is illness, upon the student's return to school, a note must be brought in to Mrs. Bell stating the reason for the absence.

If it is a planned event, please give at least TWO WEEKS written notice so that adjustments can be made before the performance.

<u>IF</u> the absence is excused, the student will be <u>expected to make a recording of all the music that he/she would have performed and turn in the recording within five school days of the missed performance, and full credit for the graded recording will be assigned. If no recording is submitted, or is submitted late, then a zero will be entered for the concert grade. Recordings must be submitted through the student's account in Charms. (www.charmsoffice.com)</u>

If the absence is unexcused, a zero will be entered for the concert grade.

Every effort will be made to avoid conflicts between extra-curricular athletic events and cocurricular programs. In the event that a conflict does occur (i.e.: a re-scheduled baseball or softball game), the student will be expected to fulfill the graded course obligation first.

<u>Concert Attire</u> - This year the choirs will be wearing shirts especially designed for the middle school choral department. More information will be sent home in the next 2 weeks. All students will be required to wear their choir shirt with khaki pants for the October, March and May concerts. No flip flops are allowed. <u>Points will be deducted from the concert grade for improper uniform.</u> The December concert will be combined with the high school and will be held at MVNU. In keeping with the formal attire that the high school students wear, I ask that for the following in December: Girls: nice dresses or skirts & blouses and dress shoes. Boys: dress shirt with collar, long tie, dress pants, and dress shoes. (When purchasing concert apparel keep in mind that dress for school activities must meet the school dress code. For example spaghetti strap dresses are not allowed.)
