

MS Girls Outscore Bobcats

The Golden Plains Middle School Lady Bulldogs extended their record to 5-2 with a 48-6 win over the Western Plains/Healy Bobcats on January 23 in Ransom.

The Bulldogs got off to a 19-4 start with 10 points from eighth grader Emma Weiner, 7 points from eighth grader Jordyn Fleckenstein, and 2 from eighth grader Valentina Bermudez.
